Audits are conducted with standard questionnaires and specific audit protocols as recommended by EPA as an excellent method to demonstrate compliance.

Guidance for standardization is provided by provisional ASTM Standard E2365-05 Standard

Guide for Environmental Compliance Performance Assessment, ISO Standard Guidelines for Environmental Auditing (ISO14010:1996), and ASTM Standards on Environmental Assessment.
